

## EMC Steals Everything They Owned - JPMorgan Chase says it's not sure if there was a court order.

### a BIGGGG screw up

**Bobo and Joy Dickson bought a house that had been headed for foreclosure, but JPMorgan Chase apparently didn't get the message that the former owners had moved out and the new owners were in the home. So, naturally, they hired a firm to drill the Dickson's locks and take everything they owned, including their food.**

"We take this very seriously, and we are working with **EMC Mortgage** [a mortgage company JPMorgan Chase owns] and the family's attorney to make this right," said Tom Kelly, a JPMorgan spokesman.

After the Dickson's bought the house back in May, the foreclosure proceedings were supposed to have been stopped. They weren't. That's when the former owner's mortgage company (owned by JPMorgan Chase) hired "Field Asset Services Inc." to drill the locks and "empty the house," according to the Austin American-Statesmen. Field Asset Services claims that **the Dickson's possessions were given to area thrift stores, but they have been unable to locate them.**

Ordinarily, when personal possessions are left in a foreclosed home a court order is needed to remove the items and the owners are given the opportunity to reclaim them within 24 hours. **JPMorgan Chase says it's not sure if there was a court order in this case.**
